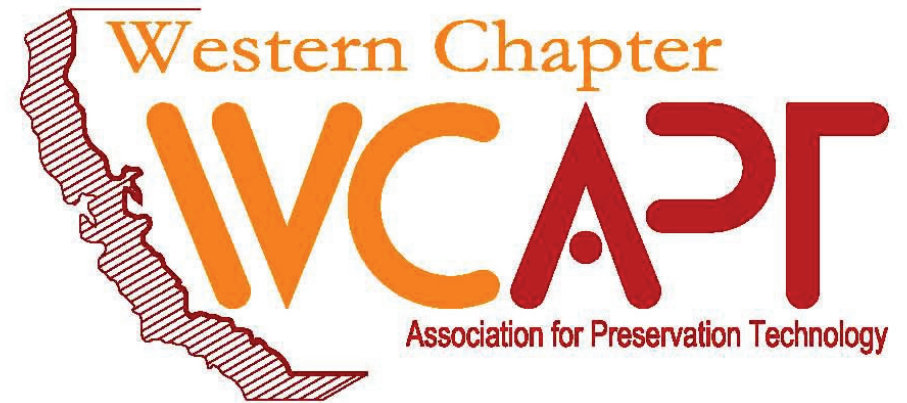


## History
